## **Reading Logs:**

We will not have the usual paper reading logs this year. You will keep track of pages you read and enter them in your Wandoo Reader account (you may call to give us your pages read and we can enter that for you if you do not have access to a computer). You will sign in to your Wandoo Reader account at [lamarlibrary.colibraries.org](http://lamarlibrary.colibraries.org) - log how many books you (and/or your children) read, complete challenges, earn credits, and be entered to win some awesome prizes this summer.

We will give out our Top Reader Awards at the end of the program, so it is very important that you log the books/pages read.

*We have set a Community Reading Goal of 75,000 pages this summer!*

## **Virtual Story Times:**

Join Ms. Cheri and Ms. Tammy as they continue their tradition of story time...but in a virtual way! They will be on Lamar Public Library's Facebook and Youtube pages every Tuesday and Thursday at 10am!

Join them virtually as they read you a story, complete the craft you received in your craft bag that week, sing songs, and much more!

## **Complete Challenges:**

We will have weekly challenges you must complete (challenges are listed in Wandoo Reader). If you complete the challenges for that week you will be entered into the weekly drawing. All challenges must be submitted by Sunday at midnight. Random weekly drawings will take place on Monday mornings, which will be announced on Facebook!

## **Craft/Activity Bags:**

Goody bags will be given out each week to Summer Reading Program participants. Each bag will contain fun activities and/or crafts. In order to receive these bags you must be a *Registered Summer Reading Program Participant*. (If you are not a registered participant you will not receive a bag.) Bags can be picked up at the library circulation desk (pending library opening), curbside pickup (call 719-336-4632 to let us know you are here), or we can deliver them to your home (within reason). New craft bags may be picked up each week beginning on Monday mornings.

## **End of the Program Awards:**

**Challenge Award:** A prize will be given to the participant that actively participated and completed ALL the weekly challenges!
